FORMSORT

Form files are labeled .DEF after the form name to show that they are form definition files.

The command line has the following format:

A FORMSORT [output .DEF filename] [/option] [input .DEF filename]

A data file must have the same name as its form file (but with the .DTA extension).

If no input .DEF file is specified, FormSort assumes it is the same as the output .DEF file.

The new .DEF file is written on the same disk as the old .DEF file.

Files may be located on any disk drive. Precede file names with drive letter and a colon (:).

OPTIONS:

To create only an index file, enter code "N".

To create only a data file, enter code "D".
