Even though Kaypro Corporation stopped producing the Kaypro II back in March, 1985, we still continued our CP/M support. However, our membership has continued to diminish and we have been forced to discontinue the publication, *Kugram*.

We have not forgotten you, the Kaypro user. We have made arrangements with The Word Processing Users' Group (W/Pug) to continue the support of all Kaypro users. They publish the enclosed newsletter, *SCROLL*. This publication covers all aspects of writing and word processing. It also contains information, articles, reviews, and news regarding the Kaypro computer.

The public domain library and all back issues of *Kugram* have been turned over to W/Pug. They will still be available to you as a W/Pug member.

We are aware that many KUG members are already subscribers to *SCROLL*. Their *SCROLL* subscriptions will be extended for the remainder of their KUG memberships.
